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1 Introduction

2 Scope

This policy applies to all employees, contractors, and stakeholders involved in Pavilion REIT's operations. To foster a culture of compliance, the policy will be shared with suppliers, partners, and consultants to demonstrate best practices. Additionally, we encourage our stakeholders, including employees, suppliers, contractors, and tenants, to adopt similar values as outlined in this policy.

3 Commitment to Occupational Safety and Health

Pavilion REIT is committed to protecting the safety and health of all members of the organization and others who may be affected by our work. We are dedicated to:

Protecting safety and health

Ensuring a safe and healthy work environment for all employees and stakeholders by adhering to the highest standards of Occupational Safety and Health.

• Preventing incidents

Preventing work-related fatalities, disabilities, injuries, ill health, diseases, property and environmental damage, and near misses through proactive safety management.

Compliance with legislation

Strict adherence to relevant national laws, including the Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 and other applicable regulations and requirements to which the organization subscribes.

• Employee consultation and participation

Ensuring that employees and their representatives are actively consulted and encouraged to participate in all elements of the Occupational Safety and Health Management System (OSHMS).



• Continuous improvement

Committing to the ongoing improvement of the OSHMS to enhance safety and health performance across all operations.

4 Compliance

Pavilion REIT adheres strictly to the Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 and its associated regulations. These regulations cover critical areas such as workplace safety standards, chemical exposure limits, noise control, and the management of hazardous substances. The Occupational Safety and Health Legislation Addendum outlines the specific regulations under this Act that are pertinent to our operations. This approach ensures that our compliance with occupational safety and health laws remains aligned with current legal standards.

Work Procedures

6 Worker Participation and Communication

The participation and consultation of workers, including their representatives where applicable, are essential to the successful development and implementation of an effective OSH policy. Pavilion REIT fosters a culture of open communication and collaboration, ensuring that OSH hazards and risks are effectively identified and addressed through cooperative efforts.

7 Health and Safety Commitment

We prioritize the well-being of our staff, tenants, and customers by adhering to the highest standards of Occupational Safety and Health. This commitment is reflected in our ongoing efforts to maintain a safe and healthy workplace, free from recognized hazards.

8 Employee Responsibilities

All Pavilion REIT employees are expected to adhere to this OSH Policy by:

• Complying with OSH regulations

Ensuring that all activities are conducted in full compliance with relevant OSH laws and regulations.

• Reporting incidents

Promptly reporting any safety incidents, near misses, or potential risks to the appropriate authorities within the organization.

Participating in safety programs

Actively engaging in initiatives aimed at improving occupational safety and health performance within the workplace.

9 Review Process

This OSH Policy will be reviewed at least once every two years by the Asset Manager of Facilities Management, Deputy CEO, CEO, or Safety and Health Committee (SHC). Any amendments must be approved by the Deputy CEO or CEO. The Occupational Safety and Health Legislation Addendum will be reviewed and updated as necessary to ensure ongoing compliance with the latest OSH legislation.
